

# INTRODUCTION TO "THE CURIOUS SAVAGE"

The central character in tonight's play is Mrs Ethel Savage. She is the step-mother of Titus Savage, a greedy overbearing and pompous Senator, Lily Belle, a spoilt and affected lady that has seen six husbands off, and Samuel, a very ineffective Judge. After Ethel has spent considerable amounts of her late husband's money on frivolous charities and the launch of a loss making play in which she starred, the family decide to commit her to the "Cloisters", a home for mentally disturbed people. Although a little eccentric she is far from mentally disturbed! The Cloisters is run by Dr. Emmett and Nurse Wilhelminia (Miss Willie). Their patients are Florence, a middle aged lady who lost a child many years before and thinks her doll is alive, Hannibal, a once clever statistition who thinks he can play the violin like Paganini, Fairy May, a young woman who wants everyone to love her, Jeffrey who was a bomber pilot in the war and was the only survivor of a crash, he thinks he has a disfigured face, and finally, Mrs Paddy, a lady of awesome ferocity who has very little to say and thinks she is an artist.

Unknown to the Savage family Mrs Savage has sold all the shares in "Savage Industries" and converted them into negotiable bonds which she has "buried" (as in funeral). The play revolves around the selfish family trying to find out where the bonds are and the impish Mrs Savage who send them on a few wild goose chases!

The play has presented the Group with a number of challenges. Firstly it is written by John Patrick, an American, and is set in America. I therefore insisted it be performed in an American accent, quite a challenge for an amateur group. Secondly there are eleven actors required plus Stage Manager, Prompt, Props Manager, Set Designer and building co-ordinator, Director, Producer and many more. I think this is the largest cast play we have put on for many a year. In some scenes they are all on at the same time. Most of you know the size of our stage so need I say more!

The author says " A play comes to life when the actors and audience are in sympathy with the playwright's intentions. The wrong interpretation distorts its meaning. It is important that the gentle inmates of "THE CLOISTERS" are played with warmth and dignity. Their "home" is not an asylum nor are these good people "lunatics". Exaggeration of the roles will rob them of charm and humour. The whole point of the play is to contrast them and Mrs Savage's children and the outside world. To depart from this endeavour will rob the play of meaning and both performers and playwright will have <u>failed</u>" He kindly did not mention the Director!

I sincerely hope you enjoy seeing "THE CURIOUS SAVAGE" as much as the cast have in rehearsing and performing it, and my producer and I have in directing it.
