Members Spotlight

Meet Chris Henley

I really owe my interest in acting and drama to my brother, Richard. We grew up very close to the Cumberbatch family in Kent, and Richard was a good friend of Benedict's father, Tim, (stage name Timothy Carlton)



who played a variety of small parts in TV dramas in the 60s/70s. Richard thought he would do likewise but our father, a naval officer, thought otherwise! My first theatre experience was aged about 5 watching Richard playing the lead role in Julius Caesar, and I was pretty much traumatised by the voluminous tomato ketchup spread all over the stage as he was murdered: I hadn't grasped the "let's pretend" element of acting and I thought he was dead.

My own first role was in the Ghost of Jerry Bundler. I have a copy of the script on foolscap paper if you are interested! I was supposed to discover the dead body, but unfortunately due to an even floorboard in our school hall, I stumbled and toppled over the prostrate form. Dramatic tension out the window! I was always involved in school plays but never in a lead role, although I did have my first experience of playing a woman in A Resounding Tinkle by NF Simpson. At university I was in Romanoff and Juliet by Peter Ustinov before having my first taste of directing with Enter a Free Man by Tom Stoppard.

My talents lay mainly dormant for years until the school where I was working became a Specialist Arts College and the Headteacher came to me and said, "We haven't really got enough Drama on the curriculum". I must have twitched or nodded because in the next breath, he said, "Why don't you take it on? You could do with a change!" I started the Drama Department from scratch and built it up over five years, the best years of my career. We did a major production every year, culminating in a play I wrote myself called A Class Act with 148 students involved, including all the boys' football team.

On retirement I thought I would fade gently away into the wings until my paths were to cross with those of David Valentine. I offered to help out if the Drama Group ever needed an extra pair of hands giving out programmes or whatever. Before I knew where I was, I was the Pantomime Dame...

ITS LIMITS ARE MAINLY WITHIN ITS OPERATORS SO IMAGINATION AND ENTHUSIASM ARE MOSTLY WHAT IS REQUIRED.
